To qualify for admission to the Weekend BSN program, you must hold a bachelor's degree in another field, submit an online admissions application and provide your official college transcripts. In addition, have completed all science prerequisite courses, including Nutrition (with a "C+" or better), within the last seven years; statistics and Developmental Psychology must be completed within the last ten years, with a passing grade, prior to beginning the Weekend BSN program.
